Great Burdock-Non-Native
Thistle Like

Queen Anne's Lace-Non-Native
Wild Carrot Family
Compound Umbrel

Ragweed-Native
Yellow Green spiky flowers
Fernlike leaves
Common source of allergies

Smartweed-Native
Sheath around each leaf
Small pink flowers
Mild water pepper
Hydropiperoid
Common name-Lady's Thumb

Daisy Fleabane-Native
Lots of ray flowers
Center has disc flowers

Asters-many Natives
Fewer(up to 20) ray flowers than fleabane
Imbrecate-like shingles
Many colors-white, purple, violet

Crown Vetch-Non-native

Jewel Weed-Native
Pale Touch Me Not
Orange-spotted Tuch Me Not

Bull Thistle-Invasive
Very toxic to livestock

White Vervain-Native
Spiky
Few flowers on spike at any one time

Red Clover-Non-native
Nitrogen fixer

Horsenettle-Native
Small blue or white flower
Kind of Nightshade
In Tomato family

Coreopsis-Non-native
Darkl center-gold petals

Teasel-Non-native
Dry, spiky stalks with prickly oval head

Ox-eye Daisy-Non-native
Invasive in MN

Reed Canary Grass-Native
Common in wetlands

Heal All or Self All-Non-native
Purple with lots of small flowers
Mint Family
Erect flower spikes and hairy bracts

Indian Tobacco-Native
Lobelia Family
5 violet blue petals
Oval fruit

Timothy Grass-Non-native
Dry Tops
Used for hay

Boneset-Native
White flat-topped, dull flowers
Hairy plant
Stem looks to grow through leaves
In Eupatorium family as is Joe-Pye weed

Yellow Wood Sorrel or Sour Grass-Native

Clover-like sour tasting leaves

Yellow flowers

Low growing

Oxalis family

Field Chickweed-Native

star-like white flowers

5 deeply notched petals look like 10

Low growing

Belongs to Pinks family

Cinquefoil-Non-native

Small creeping-looks like strawberry

Small yellow flowers

Tall Ironweed-Native

Tall and erect plant

Deep purple-blue flowers in clusters

Leaves downy underneath

Wild Mint-Native

Purple, white or pink flowers

Flowers circle square stem

Aromatic

Lance Leaf Goldenrod-Native

Flat-topped cluster of yellow flowerheads

Downy stem

Narrow, pointy leaves

Purple-Stemmed Aster-Native

Fuzzy, purple stem

Leaves partially wrap around flower stem

White flowers

Sometimes called Swamp Aster

Curly Dock-Non Native

Dried stalks about 3 feet high

Rusty brown seed heads in fall

Reddish branching flower cluster earlier

Evening Primrose-Native

3-4 feet Tall

Hairy, reddish-purple stalk

Large yellow flowers

Willow Herb

Common in wetlands

Epilobium family

white petals come out at tip of long tube

Grow in water

Common Yarrow or Milfoil-Native

Clusters of small whitish flowers

Gray-green hairystem

Gray-green fern-like leaves

Common Sunflower-Native

Tall erect stem

Yellow flower rays around brownish center
